The Town Council of the Town of Milton will hold a Public Hearing on Monday, April 7, 2008, at 7:00 p.m. in the Milton Theatre located at 110 Union Street, Milton, Delaware on the following item:

A RESOLUTION TO REQUEST THE HISTORIC PRESERVATION COMMISSION TO REVIEW THE HISTORIC PRESERVATION DISTRICT ORDINANCES REGARDING RENOVATION AND DEMOLITION.

WHEREAS, Mayor and Council of the Town of Milton wish the Historic Preservation Commission to review the Historic Preservation District ordinances regarding renovation and demolition within the district for health, safety and permit requirements; and

WHEREAS, the review of said ordinances shall be completed in order to report back to the Mayor and Council of the Town of Milton by July 25, 2008 so the report and new ordinances if necessary can be presented at the August 4, 2008 Town Council meeting, and referred to Planning and Zoning for consideration at their meeting of August 19, 2008 and a public hearing on September 2, 2008, Town Council meeting; and

WHEREAS, during this time period public comment will be received until the Public Hearing at the Town Council meeting on September 2, 2008

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Town Council of the Town of Milton, that the Historic Preservation Commission review the Historic Preservation District ordinances regarding renovation and demolition within the district for health, safety and permit requirements.

The first reading of the proposed changed was read at the March 3, 2008 Council meeting.

The proposed ordinance amendment is available for public inspection at the Town Hall located at 115 Federal Street during the hours of 8:30 a.m.-5:00 p.m., Monday – Friday. All interested parties are invited to attend and comment on the application. If unable to attend the public hearing, written comments will be accepted at the Town Hall, but must be received prior to the public hearing. Said hearing may be adjourned without further notice.
