PUBLIC NOTICE**


Dear Residents of the Town of Milton:

In an effort to resolve the Town's wastewater treatment problems, the Town Council and I voted to privatize Milton's wastewater management. We entered into a contract with Tidewater Environmental Services, Inc. to take over wastewater services in the Town of Milton. In addition the Town annexed land pursuant to a request from Key Ventures LLC; part of which was to be used as land for the construction of a new wastewater treatment facility.

A lawsuit was later filed challenging our actions which the plaintiffs alleged to be an attempt at contract zoning. In the interest of settling the pending legal action, we acknowledge that some of our actions were considered to be procedurally and legally improper and inconsistent with the Town Charter and Code. We understand that to be the position taken by the plaintiffs who filed the pending legal action. The Town Council continues to disagree with the position taken by the plaintiffs. A judicial determination as to which position is correct has not been made. However both parties have voluntarily agreed to settle the pending legal action in the best interest of the Town and its citizens.

Therefore, as part of the settlement of this matter, the Town Council wishes to apologize to the residents of the Town of Milton for any confusion or concern our actions may have caused. We will continue to work diligently to ensure that all of our actions comply with all applicable laws and we hope that the Town will be a more peaceful place in the years to come.
